# The third ČAG pre-conference Workshop will be focused on the geotechnical monitoring of landslides.

The general aim of the workshop will be to introduce the traditional geotechnical monitoring technique – borehole inclinometry, including data processing and interpretation. The first part of the workshop will be devoted to field data acquisition, while the second part will be focused on data processing and interpretation. In addition, several examples from different sites will be presented and discussed.

Furthermore, the issue of the influence of temperature variation on geotechnical measurements will be presented. What is the cause, how to quantify its influence on the measurements and how to compensate for this negative phenomenon? That will be the main questions during the third part of the workshop.

The workshop will take place on 18 April afternoon (fieldwork on Březno u Postoloprt) and 19 April morning (data processing and interpretation in Most). The workshop is intended for pre- and post-gradual students, and it is free of charge. Due to the limited number of participants, it is advisable to reserve your place well in advance.

### **Conference excursion**

During the conference excurison (field trip), we will visit the open-cast brown coal mines in the North-Bohemian Basin. The plan is to use special trucks that can take us down to the mines, where specific anthropogenic landforms can be seen. This is to be confirmed yet, however. In any case, it is advisable to be prepared for a muddy terrain down in the mines.
